Implementing partners, networks and strategic partnerships – Partnership Countries

AADK have over 100 implementing partners in 9 partnership countries. The ActionAid office in each of the countries is the main partner. The ActionAid offices are local NGOs with own boards, members and constituency.

The partnership policy of AAI recognizes the variety of AA relationships, and conceptualises both formal strategic partnerships based on a formal agreement/MoU as well as campaign and policy alliances, networks and coalitions involving e.g. social movements, the private sector, public institutions, think tanks etc.

On the **partnership programmes** (Country support) the AA office has a range of local partners at local, district and national level, that are carrying out activities (capacity development, facilitating community engagement, social audits, score cards, anti-corruption, advocacy and campaigning). In addition to this AA engage in various networks coalitions and campaigns – e.g. on tax and anti-corruption.

In each of the AA countries is a youth network supported by AA, called **Activista**.

Through the AADK modality **People4Change (P4C)**, Advisors and Inspirators are placed with local partners. In 2015, P4C inspirators supported 89 organisations and in 2017, 43 partner organisations were supported.

The **Training4Change** consists of the Global Platforms and TCDC. AADK is in cooperation with the AA country offices running 8 Global Platforms focusing on youth activism. In addition to this is the Training Centre in Tanzania (TCDC) focusing on governance and leadership training. The participants are from NGOs, youth groups and movements.

In 2017, the participants at the Global Platforms represented 1,174 organisations.

In 2015, TCDC trained representatives from 469 organisations.
